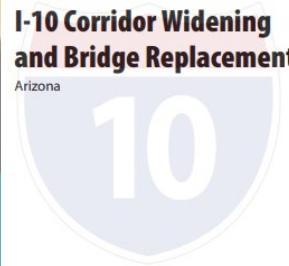

- 5 Tribes received an award of operating funds from the ADOT 5311 CARES Act funding which was transferred to FTA so since the tribes requested that they apply directly to FTA for the funding. The 5 tribes are: Navajo Nation, White Mountain Apache Tribe, San Carlos Apache Tribe, Hualapai Tribe, and Hopi Tribe.
- Total funding set aside for the tribes listed above = \$5,521,875
- TOTAL Obligation + Tribal Allocation \$41,730,201
10% of this total is for State Administration

FAA CARES Act Funding - Aviation

FAA CARES Act funding consisted of a reduction in the match for all qualified FAA Airport Improvement Project Grants for FFY 2020. The standard recipient match is approximately ten percent (10%+/-). Aeronautics Federal/State/Local (FSL) grant program provides the FAA grant recipient an additional grant of one half of the recipient's match, or roughly five percent (5%+/-) of the FAA grant amount.

The FY 2020 Five Year Transportation Construction Program has \$5 million dollars allocated to the FSL grant program which will no longer be utilized as match funds.

Utilization of the FSL Funds will be determined and recommended with the 2021-2025 Five Year Transportation Construction Program, once funding projections for the aviation fund are established.
