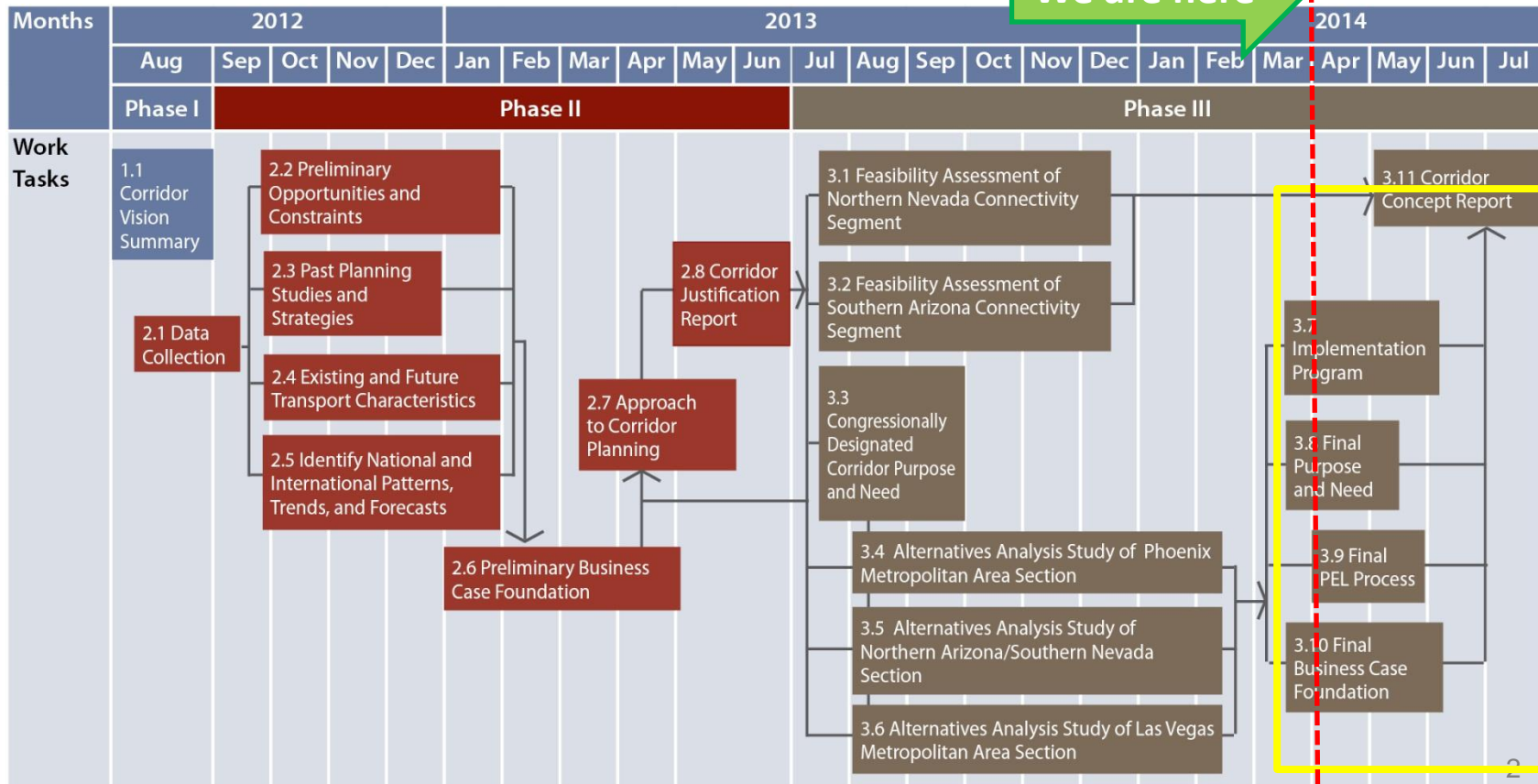
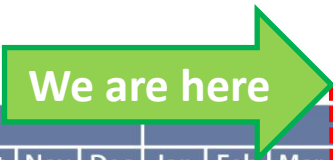

- Future Corridor Signs along US 93 (4 locations)



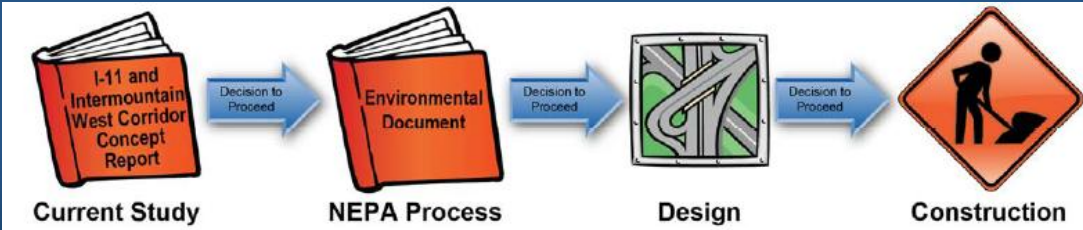
