Separate from our project, the Town of Florence has a project on Diversion Dam Road with roadway widening and utility relocation work which must be completed before our construction project can proceed. At this time, construction work on the Town's project has not started. It is not in the best interests of the Department to award a contract in which our contractor cannot start or proceed with work in a timely manner. The Department recommends the Board postpone action on this item until its March meeting. The Department will meet with the Town of Florence to determine the nature of the delay and anticipated schedule for their roadway and utility relocation work and provide a recommendation to the Board for our project at the March 20, 2015 meeting.
