




Comparison of 2003 RTP and Current Highway User Revenue Fund Projections

Uses of Dedicated Local & Regional Funds








GASOLINE TAXES


Annual Average Net New Statewide Revenue

2013 to 2022 (millions of dollars)










Potential Transportation Revenue Sources
