# Recommendations Regarding Project-Related Public Comments

#### Preservation and/or Modernization Projects:

- In cases of ongoing/recent studies (e.g. SR191 and SR64) Any project recommendations arising from studies will be considered in the *next* Program Cycle (FY2020-2024) and would compete with other project recommendations statewide.
- Other project recommendations will also be considered to compete statewide in the next Program Cycle (FY2020-2024).

# Recommendations Regarding Project-Related Public Comments (Cont'd)

#### Expansion Projects:

- May be considered for the *next* Program Cycle (FY2020-2024), in competition with other Expansion project recommendations statewide, *only* under one or more of the following scenarios:
  - A federal grant award is made;
  - A third party provides a funding contribution; and/or
  - A public-private partnership is arranged.
- Consideration is contingent on the project scoring high enough in ADOT's Planning to Programming process to be eligible for funding.
   Otherwise, no new Expansion projects will be recommended.




