Welcome to a meeting of the Arizona State Transportation Board. The Transportation Board consists of seven private citizen members appointed by the Governor, representing specific transportation districts. Board members are appointed for terms of six years each, with terms expiring on the third Monday in January of the appropriate year.

BOARD AUTHORITY

Although the administration of the Department of Transportation is the responsibility of the director, the Transportation Board has been granted certain policy powers in addition to serving in an advisory capacity to the director. In the area of highways the Transportation Board is responsible for establishing a system of state routes. It determines which routes are accepted into the state system and which state routes are to be improved. The Board has final authority on establishing the opening, relocating, altering, vacating or abandoning any portion of a state route or a state highway. The Transportation Board awards construction contracts and monitors the status of construction projects. With respect to aeronautics the Transportation Board distributes monies appropriated to the Aeronautics Division from the State Aviation Fund for planning, design, development, land acquisition, construction and improvement of publicly-owned airport facilities. The Board also approves airport construction. The Transportation Board has the exclusive authority to issue revenue bonds for financing needed transportation improvements throughout the state. As part of the planning process the Board determines priority planning with respect to transportation facilities and annually adopts the five year construction program.

PUBLIC INPUT

Members of the public may appear before the Transportation Board to be heard on any transportation-related issue. Persons wishing to protest any action taken or contemplated by the Board may appear before this open forum. The Board welcomes public involvement, although because of Arizona's open meeting laws, no actions may be taken on items which do not appear on the formal agenda. This does not, however, preclude discussion of other issues.

MEETINGS

The Transportation Board typically meets on the third Friday of each month. Meetings are held in locations throughout the state. In addition to the regular business meetings held each month, the Board also conducts three public hearings each year to receive input regarding the proposed five-year construction program. Meeting dates are established for the following year at the December organization meeting of the Board.

BOARD MEETING PROCEDURE

Board members receive the agenda and all backup information one week before the meeting is held. They have studied each item on the agenda and have consulted with Department of Transportation staff when necessary. If no additional facts are presented at the meeting, they often act on matters, particularly routine ones, without further discussion. In order to streamline the meetings the Board has adopted the "consent agenda" format, allowing agenda items to be voted on en masse unless discussion is requested by one of the board members or Department of Transportation staff members.

Any agenda item identified by any Board member as one requiring discussion will be accelerated ahead of those items not identified as requiring discussion. All such accelerated agenda items will be individually considered and acted upon ahead of all other agenda items. With respect to all agenda items not accelerated. i.e., those items upon which action has been deferred until later in the meeting, the Chairman will entertain a single motion and a single second to that motion and will call for a single vote of the members without any discussion of any agenda items so grouped together and so singly acted upon. 

Reasons for the need of additional funding are as follows:

Original approved funding request included the tasks of scoping the scour retrofit and bridge deck joint repair and final design. The estimated effort for developing the scoping document and 30pct level plans was approximately \$15K. After the project was established, the scoping task for this project was re-assigned to Roadway Pre-Design on behalf of Bridge Group. Prior to this assignment, projects of similar objectives and needs were scoped solely by Bridge Group Staff. The task was for Pre-Design to develop the document with support of Bridge Group on structure related items. This process did not work out well with both groups expending approximately \$56K in delivering the scoping document and 30pct level plans.

The two groups have re-evaluated the processes taken on this project and have identified improvements to define an appropriate level of effort necessary to develop scoping documents for future projects. Bridge Group will remain the lead in developing in-house bridge design scoping documents.

The estimated effort for Environmental work was originally estimated at \$45K for consultant services. After scoping was completed, it was identified that additional work will be necessary to clear the project resulting in an additional \$35K for consulting services.

The original estimated effort for Right of Way clearance was estimated at \$10K. During the scoping process, it was identified that temporary construction easements (TCE) will be required, resulting in a need for additional funds. (\$61K)

As a result of depleted funding from the expenditures noted above and underestimated tasks, additional funding for the Tyson Wash project is necessary to complete the project.

Estimate for Tyson Wash Scope: Staff = \$119K Consultant = \$35K

Bridge Group is also requesting a change in scope to repair the superstructure damage at the Quartzsite Pedestrian bridge. This work will require funding to complete design.

Estimate for Quartzsite Ped Bridge: Staff = \$12K Consultant = \$12K




