# Legislative Capital Outlay Appropriations

- Funding for projects on the State System
  1. Repave SR 69 in Prescott Valley, \$4.7M
  2. Improve US 95, \$10M
  3. Repave SR 95 in Mohave County, \$46.7M
  4. Study the North/South Corridor in Pinal County, \$4.0M
  5. Study and DCR for repair of SR 88, \$0.7M
  6. Repair SR 186 & SR B10 in Wilcox, \$3.5M
  7. Rehabilitate Pavement on SR 77 near Oro Valley, \$13.6M
  8. Improve SR 90 near Fort Huachuca, \$10.6M
  9. Study guardrail and shoulder of SR 377, Holbrook to Heber, \$0.14M
  10. Pavement Rehabilitation Projects, Fair and Poor Condition Pavement to Good, Not in Maricopa or Pinal Counties, Not in 2022-2026 Program, \$90M
  11. I-10 Widening between Phoenix and Casa Grande, \$50M
  12. Aviation Fund additional appropriation, \$18M

# Legislative Capital Outlay Appropriations

- Funding for projects in MAG Region
  1. Study interchange ramps at Grand Ave and SR 303, \$0.15M
  2. Construct Overpass at Riggs Road and SR 347, \$25M
  3. Study Overpass at Riggs Road and SR 347, \$2.5M
  4. Final Design, Right-of-way and easements for overpass at Riggs Road and SR 347, \$7.5M
  5. Improve Drainage on 67th Ave in Peoria, \$8.5M
  6. Widen Camelback Road between SR 303 and Litchfield Road in Goodyear, \$8M
  7. Construct bridge and Extend Ocotillo Road in Gilbert, \$7.9M

# Legislative Capital Outlay Appropriations

- Funding for projects in Greater Arizona (Not on State System)
  1. Repair and maintain 20th Avenue in Safford, \$1,032,100
  2. Improve Tangerine Road Near I-10, \$5M
  3. Replace Butte Avenue bridge in Florence, \$1.0M
  4. Improve Main Street in Jerome, \$0.56M

# Tribal Transportation Update

## **2021-2022 Inter Tribal Council of Arizona (ITCA) Transportation Working Group (TWG)**

**Project** - This project enables ITCA and ADOT to conduct TWG meetings which are an effective forum for sharing federal, state and tribal transportation information and for follow-up strategy development. Development of a contract for fiscal year 2022 is currently underway.

## **2022 Arizona Tribal Traffic Safety and Injury Prevention Summit**

ADOT, ADHS and other state and federal agencies are collaborating to plan this Summit for February 2022. The Summit will include multi-agency track sessions and tribal speakers. Summit topics will focus on effective strategies that reduce motor vehicle crashes and pedestrian fatalities and increase personal safety on tribal lands.

# Tribal Transportation Update

**ADOT transfers include \$2.2 M in Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funding for 2 projects:**

- **Colorado River Indian Tribes**

  - 2020 ADOT-HSIP transfer of \$1,740,699

  - Scope: 39 miles of centerline and shoulder rumble strips, pavement markings, signage on Mohave Road (Design underway)

- **Hualapai Indian Tribe**

  - 2021 ADOT-HSIP transfer of \$566,000.00

  - Scope: 10 miles of centerline and shoulder rumble strips on Diamond Bar Road (IGA underway)

# Tribal Transportation Update

**ADOT will administer the design, advertisement, bid and award; and administer the construction of the following project:**

- San Carlos Apache Tribe**

2021 ADOT-HSIP award of \$978,611

Scope: 2.2 miles of street lights, pavement striping and markers on White Mountain Road and Airport Road (IGA executed May)
