


Organization Chart

ADOT Tribal Planning Program Managers/ADOT Tribal Liaisons Roles & Responsibilities

- Provide transportation planning support and intergovernmental coordination for ADOT's statewide and regional planning projects and programs.
- Coordinate efforts to improve tribal participation in statewide transportation planning and programming processes.
- Provide statewide tribal outreach coordination and consultation assistance to ADOT personnel, planning stakeholders and ADOT consultants and contractors.
- Maintain compliance with A.R.S. 41-2051(C) Responsibilities of State Agencies and ADOT MGT-16.01 Department-Wide Native Nation/Tribal Government Consultation Policy.

Internal & External Tribal Coordination and Outreach Assistance Example Consultation Actions

- State Aviation Fund Tribal Airport Participation
 - Few Tribal Airport Projects were being funded through the State Aviation Fund.

 Tribal Liaisons in coordination with the ADOT Aeronautics Group and ADOT

 Planning and Programming Group initiated an outreach effort with 12 Tribal

 Airports to understand why the were not participating in the State Aviation Fund

 Program.
 - O Challenges were identified through a PDCA process and follow up is underway.
- AZ Long Range Transportation Plan Update Tribal Participation
 - Tribal Liaisons participate on the project technical advisory committee.
 - Outreach letters were distributed to all 22 Tribal Leaders in August.
 - A second notification was sent out in September.
 - Currently there are 12 Tribes that have requested consultation with ADOT on the development of the LRTP.
 - Consultation meetings are currently scheduled with 8 Tribes.

		Honorable Timothy Nuvangyaoma, Hopi Chairman	Hopi Tribe	Chairman Timothy Nuvangyaoma mentioned that the Tibe hosted the STB meeting in November 2019 at the Moenkopi Community. At that time issues on SR 264 and other roads on Hopi were presented. However, he does not feel that their voices were heard. Traffic has increased and road maintenance is required. He expressed that today we need to work together to address the concerns of the Hopi. We need to address safety issues on SR 264 running from east to west. Also on SR 87 from the southern end to the SR 264 junction.
