




North-South Corridor Tier 1 EIS Overview

The Study Area was approximately 50 miles long between Apache Junction and Eloy, and traverses central Pinal County.

Tier 1 was completed in 2021





Current Activities

- Tier 2 EIS & DCR is the next step.
- Study was divided into two segments
 - Segment 1 extends from US 60 to Arizona Farms
 Road (20 miles)-- Public information completed in
 October 2023. Completion date 2026.
 - Segment 2 extends from Arizona Farms Road to I-10 (30 miles): Procurement Phase


