Tribal Traffic Count Coordination Efforts

The ADOT MPD Traffic Monitoring Group met with two Tribes and the BIA to discuss efforts in partnering to obtain and/or conduct volume counts on Tribal Routes. Tribal outreach meetings included:

- Tohono O’Odham Nation - 10/28/24
- Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community - 10/28/24
- USDOJ - Bureau of Indian Affairs Western Region - 10/30/24

Both Tribes are open to working with ADOT to obtain counts for current and new routes that will update the ADOT Highway Performance Monitoring System database.
