# Santa Cruz County - Ruby Road Bridge

- Board awarded \$3.3 mil for Match on the Reconnecting Communities federal grant on 3/15/24
- County originally requested Match for construction phase only
- Applicant was awarded \$6.6 mil federal grant
- To provide greater flexibility in delivering the project, Santa Cruz County has requested Match be expanded to all phases of the project, including design, right of way, construction and other phases which may be needed
- Change is consistent with AZ SMART statute
- Amount and purpose of the AZ SMART grant does not change

**Requested action** - approve the expansion of the \$3.3 mil Match award made on 3/15/24 from construction only to all phases of the project

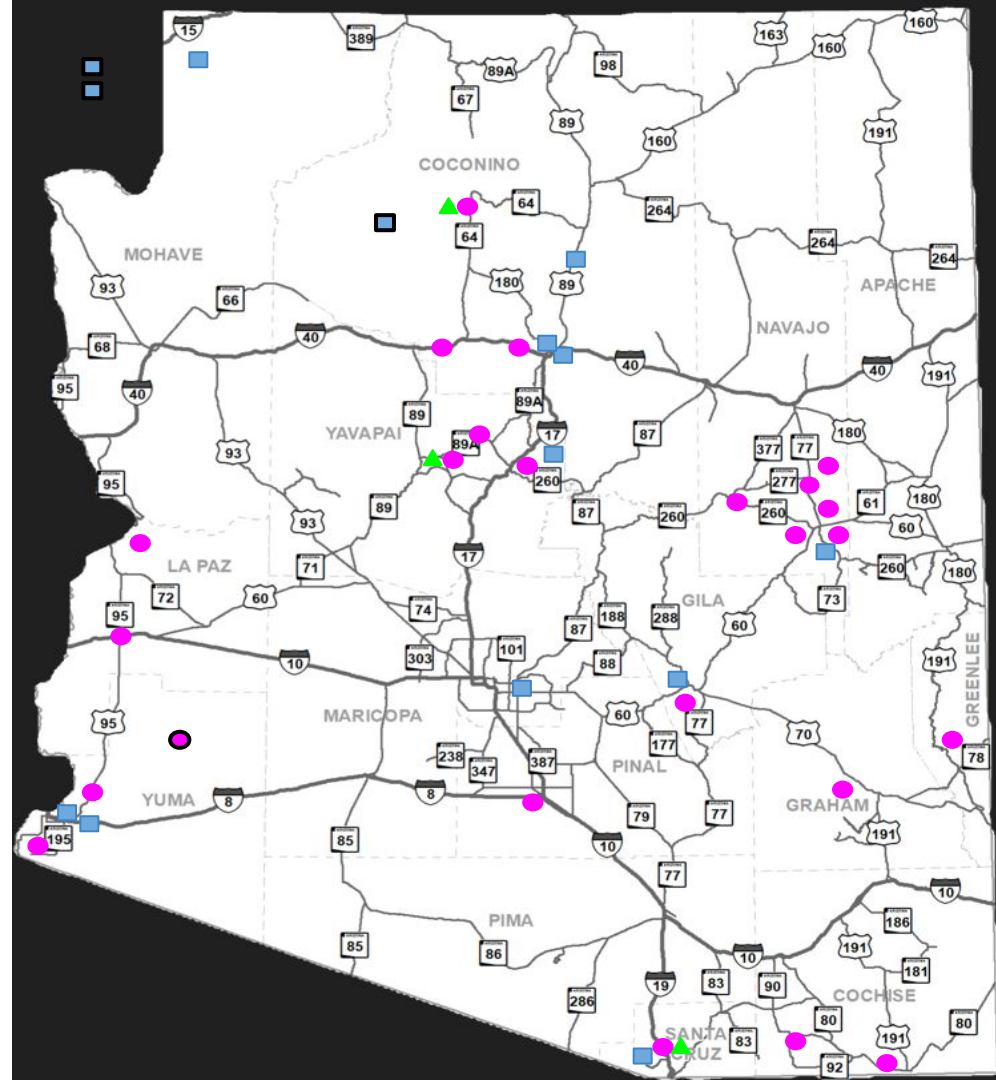
