Key Dates Ahead



Today is the final day for House committees to hear House bills (and Senate committees to hear Senate bills). This deadline will signal the end of most of the 1,800 bills/resolutions.

- Friday, Feb. 28: Marks the end of "crossover week" by which all bills must be voted out of their chamber of origin and be sent to the opposing chamber.
- Friday, March 28: The deadline for House bills to pass through Senate committees (and vice versa).
- Tuesday, April 22: The 100th day of the legislative session, at which time lawmakers are supposed to wrap up their work (though they rarely make that deadline).

Transportation Funding Bills of Interest



HB2101: Appropriation; match advantage; rural transportation (not heard in committee)

Appropriates \$10M from the General Fund in FY25-26 to the AZ SMART fund for rural transportation improvements and maintenance.

HB2304 - Appropriations; highway and road projects (not heard in committee) Annual RTAC bill with appropriations of varying amounts in FY25-26 to ADOT to complete transportation infrastructure projects designated as regional priorities by multiple governing and planning organizations.

HB2557 - Appropriation; State Route 347; widening (not heard in committee)
Appropriates \$16,291,610 from the General Fund in FY25-26 to ADOT to widen and improve SR 347 between I-10 and the city of Maricopa.

Transportation Funding Bills of Interest



HB2192: Appropriations; Interstate 10; vehicle lanes (passed the House)

Appropriates \$70M from the General Fund in FY25-26 and \$50M in FY26-27 to ADOT for the design and construction of additional vehicle lanes, separated by a lighted median, on Interstate 10 between State Route 85 and Citrus Rd.

HB2858: Appropriation; Glendale; 75th Avenue reconstruction (passed House Approps)

Appropriates \$3M from the General Fund in FY25-26 to ADOT to distribute to the City of Glendale for the 75th Avenue reconstruction project provided Glendale demonstrates the city is committed to matching monies of gifts, grants, and donations in the amount of at least 20% of the total estimated cost of the project from other sources.

Transportation Funding Bills of Interest



SB1162: Appropriation; highway project; Patagonia; use (passed Senate Public Safety & Approps)

Permits Patagonia to use monies previously distributed to the town by ADOT to reconstruct McKeown avenue between 3rd Ave. West and State Route 82, in addition to any other prescribed use.

SB1617: Appropriation; State Route 347 (passed Senate approps)

Appropriates \$49M from the General Fund in FY25-26 to ADOT to construct an overpass at Riggs Road and SR 347.
