Tribal Transportation Updates

ADOT Redesignation of Critical Freight Corridors Project - Tribal Outreach

- This project will update the designation of statewide system of critical urban and rural freight corridors on the National Highway Freight Network (NHFN).
- This is also to review the potential to add additional miles to the NHFN for future programming of federal funds.
- ADOT held a tribal outreach meeting on April 11th to inform tribal officials
- Invitations were sent to lead tribal transportation contacts for all 22 tribes in Arizona. Several tribal communities participated in the meeting.
- The ADOT Tribal Liaisons also provided information to the project managers on tribal concerns pertaining to corridors crossing their communities.
- Tribal outreach will continue throughout the project process to provide the opportunity for participation in technical advisory committee meetings.

Tribal Transportation Updates

ADOT Road Safety Assessment (RSA) Project Update - US 89 MP 480-525

- An RSA project is in progress for the location indicated above.
- This project is in coordination with Navajo Nation, Bodaway Gap Chapter.
- The Field Reviews were conducted on May 8-9. Observations included school bus stop locations, traffic turn lane locations and water haul locations.
- Traffic data, collision data and other data that has been collected will be reviewed.
- The RSA analysis will identify and prioritize safety issues.
- A Draft Report will be available 6/27 for feedback and review
- Final Report expected to be completed by 7/31.
