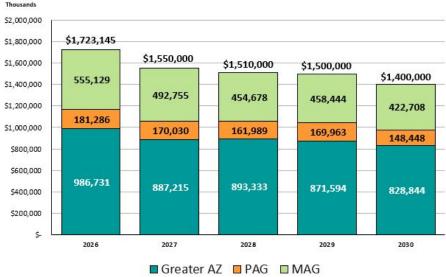

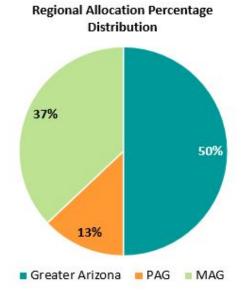


Regional Funding for 2026-2030 5-yr Program

Greater Arizona Highway Projects

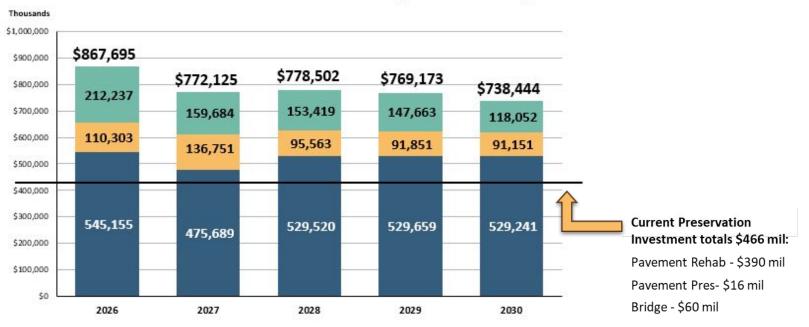

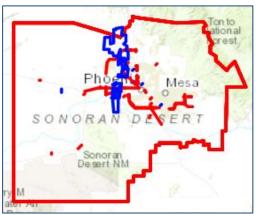
Greater AZ - ADOT System Only

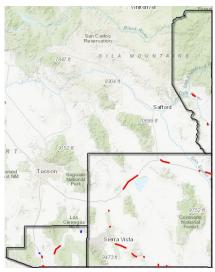

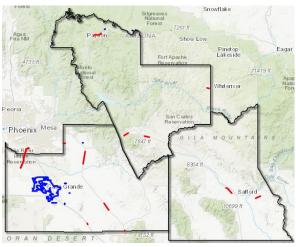

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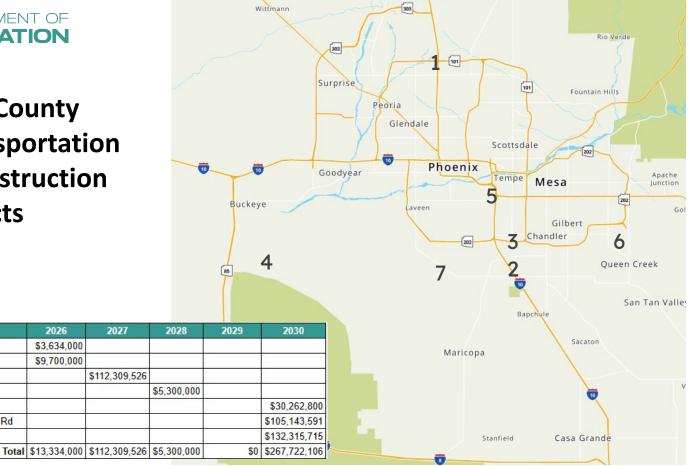

- Section also includes additional funding provided by the region





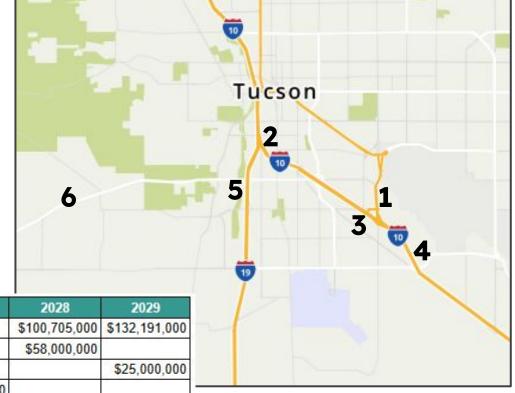
I-10 Widening, Country Club Rd and Kino Pkwy TIs
