Tribal Transportation Updates

2025 (July) ADOT Intergovernmental Funds Transfer Agreements

- **ADOT transferred \$4.8M in construction funding for 4 tribal projects:**

Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community

2025 MAG-CMAQ transfer of \$1,296,587

Scope: Pave dirt roads – Clarendon (ongoing)

2025 MAG-CMAQ transfer of \$2,894,350

Scope: Pave dirt roads – Jackrabbit (ongoing)

2025 MAG-CMAQ transfer of \$623,607

Scope: Pave dirt roads – Osborn (ongoing)

2025 Off System Bridge Program-STBGP transfer of \$103,730

Scope: Scoping Document – Alma School Road Bridge (ongoing)

Tribal Transportation Updates

Federal Funds Award for ADOT Administered Tribal Project

- **ADOT will administer design, advertisement, bid, award, and construction of the following project for the San Carlos Apache Tribe:**

2025 ADOT-HSIP award of \$2,075,000

Scope: Streetlighting, pavement striping and markers on White Mountain Road and Airport Road (IGA executed July)

- **ADOT Southeast District - San Carlos Apache Tribe**
A passing lane project within the San Carlos Apache Reservation began in July on US 70 from MP 288 to MP 289 west of Bylas. The project will provide a 1-mile westbound passing lane, drainage improvements and new pavement markings. The work is scheduled to be completed in December 2025.
