# Major Themes in Public Comments

Route	# of Comments	Major Themes
SR 347	19	Public comments overwhelmingly emphasize the urgent need for improvements to SR 347 between I-10 and the City of Maricopa. Residents consistently describe the corridor as dangerous, congested and unable to support the rapid population growth in Maricopa. Many commuters report significantly longer travel times and express concern that heavy congestion is contributing to frustration, risky driving behavior and frequent accidents.
I-10	14	Public comments express strong concern about safety, congestion, and poor road conditions along Interstate 10 and nearby highways. Residents report dangerous driving, potholes, and severe bottlenecks, particularly near Phoenix, Tucson, and growing areas of Pinal County. Many commenters call for lane expansions, repairs and improved traffic flow.
SR 60 / US 60	10	Public comments highlight concerns about roadway safety, deteriorating pavement conditions, and increasing congestion, particularly along US 60. Many commenters report heavy traffic, long delays, and dangerous driving conditions as population growth continues to outpace roadway capacity. Commenters frequently request widening projects, additional lanes, and improved traffic flow through key areas such as Gold Canyon, Queen Creek Canyon, and between Globe and Show Low.
